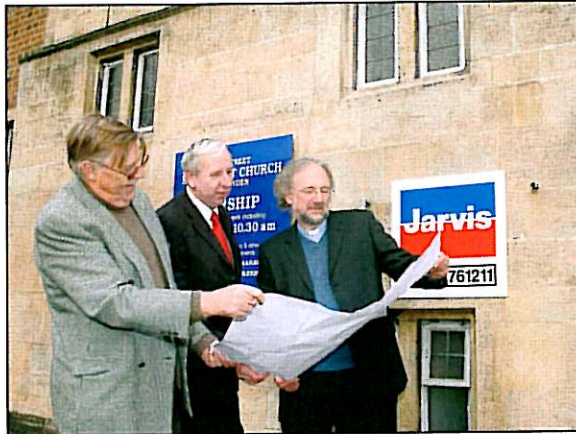


Jarvis Prayers Answered

Jarvis will shortly commence building work on the Methodist Church in Harpenden, the second major contract for them on the property. The project, which has been won in open tender, is worth approximately £640k will provide an extension to the main hall to incorporate a new kitchen, an extension to the church building to form a new Youth Centre together with refurbishment and alterations to the main worship and ancillary areas.

The contract begins mid February and should take approximately 35 weeks to complete. The 'High Street Church' as it is known locally was rebuilt in 1929, has a 1,000 strong community and a prominent location in Harpenden's centre.

The project has been phased to enable the church to stay in operation throughout and weekend services will not be affected. It will also be business as usual for many of the church's facilities such as Wesley's coffee shop and the High Street should see minimal disruption with Jarvis using the rear of the building for deliveries and access.

Reverend Peter Barber said 'he was very pleased that the works are now going ahead and that local builder Jarvis had secured the contract'.
